On August 1. President Clinton nominated Regina Keeney, current chief of the FCC's Common Carrier Bureau and a former member of the Senate Commerce Committee, to fill the Republican seat on the FCC Commissioner's board vacated in March by Andrew Barrett, If confirmed, Keeney will serve on the board for the four years remaining of Barrett's term, through June 2000. It will also result in an historic first, as a majority of the five FCC commissigners will now be women

"I am extremely pleased [by Keeney's appointment]," said FCC Chairman Reed Hundt. This history-making nomination could not be better timed. She has both the experience and acumen to brang new distinction and invaluable wisdom to the com-

Manage and Propens Warris Woomer save bheir Older sons the usual family names: David. John. Moses. Thomas and William, and the daughters: roses, inodes and william, and the daughter Frances. Elizabeth, Catherine. But the two vounger sons. Poster H. and Stires Jada suct have been named after neighbors or friends. The older children were already married when

the Yearneys left Greenbrier by way of Giles Co. to settle on Cabin Creek. All. it seems. became engaged in lumbering and boating, taking them up and down the Kanawha and Ohio rivers. Moses, Jr. (1797-1890) and Poster H.(1811-c. 1879) married sisters. Mary D. E. Eliza J. Huff. Mary, like her husband, lived a long life, but Flire diad after the hirth of her last child and the young Eliza Jane was raised by Nary and Moses. Meanwhile, the POSTER KEENEY family was coattered among Foster's older children. branching out from Lincoln and Booce counties WV to Caboll Vanauba and Logan counties due to the fact that coal mining became the leading industry, attracting many of the young Keeneys. FOSTER H. KERNRY was born in 1811 in Greenbrier

Co., then VA. He is Listed in the 1850 and 1860 Kanawha census report and in Lincoln Co. in 1870. On 17 Pehrnary 1843 he was married to Elizabeth (Eliza) Jane Huff, by Rev. Samuel Maddov. Hardesty's WV history lists Fliga's life

span as 1816-1864

WILLIAM R. KEENEY (1845-c.1878), the oldest son, was born in 1845. The 1870 census shows him living with his father's family. He is not listed in later census reports, but his last child was born in 1876. He and his father died at about the same time. 
